Patient Survey Feedback Streatham High Practice.

The survey was carried out by Streatham High Pratice in January 2013. Questionnaires were distributed to patients following consultations with all employed Doctors over a two week period. Completed surveys were collated and analysed for discussion internally within the practice and with our Patient Group. The practice achieved a response of 160 questionnaires. GPAQ version 3 questions were included as these reflected the issues we and patients wanted to explore further. GPAQ Questions included from GPAQ are copyright of the University of Cambridge/University of Manchester. GPAQ was originally developed from the PCAS survey with the permission of Dr Dana Gelb Safran.
